Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.244 dated 01.11.2020, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, HSIDC, Barhi, District Sonapat and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.03.2021 (P-2).

2. It transpires that the then Coordinate Bench on 13.03.2023, passed the following order:-

“Report dated 22.10.2021 of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ganaur has been received according to which there are two aggrieved persons i.e., the complainant namely Manish Dhankhar and the victim namely Sagar. The said Sagar has not been made a party.

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for time to add Sagar as a party respondent and also to place on record a compromise with him.

Adjourned to 11.05.2023.”

3. On 11.05.2023, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioners as well as respondent No.2 and again on 16.10.2023, position remained the same.
4. Today also, no one has come forward on behalf of the parties, i.e. petitioners and respondent No.2, to pursue the matter.
5. In view of the above, this Court is left with no option, except to observe that there is no compromise between the parties. Hence, petition is disposed off accordingly, at this stage.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
7. Needless to say, that if an occasion so arises, petitioners may take recourse to the remedy available under law.
