AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On 02.09.2024, the following order was passed:-

“During pendency of the appeal the appellant had died and Smt. Harjeet Kaur, his mother was brought on record as his legal heir. After discussion it is stated by counsel for the appellant that in case, an amount of Rs.18,50,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Lac Fifty Thousand only) is paid, over and above the amount already paid by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ludhiana, this appeal can be settled. Counsel for appellant has also signed the proposal sheet.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company seeks an adjournment to get instructions.

On his request, adjourned to 09.09.2024.”

Mr. Lalit Garg, Advocate, Mr. R.C. Kapoor, Advocate and representative for respondent No.3-Insurance Company have also signed the said statement today, accepting the proposal made by the counsel for the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that agreed amount be released in favour of legal representative No.ii-Harjeet Kaur. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other legal representatives of the

appellant-Raji Paintal, the legal representative No.ii-Harjeet Kaur shall indemnify

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the said legal representatives.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.18,50,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) favouring legal representative No.ii-Harjeet Kaur, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 04.11.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
