2. Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and exemption from filing the certified/true typed copies of Annexure P-1 to Annexure P-3 is granted as prayed for.

3. Disposed of.

MAIN CASE

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to take appropriate action as per law against respondents No.4 to 6 on representation/complaint dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner to respondent No.2.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No. 4 to 6, the petitioner had moved the representation to the competent authorities for taking appropriate legal action but no action thereon has been taken. He



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had moved the representation (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioner. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- The Superintendent of Police, District Palwal, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that respondent No.2- The Superintendent of Police, District Palwal, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Superintendent of Police, District Palwal, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
- 6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 7. Disposed of.
