- Through the instant petition, filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., prayer is made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3, to take immediate action on the applications dated 16.06.2022 and 20.06.2022 (Annexures P-3 and P-4), respectively moved by the petitioner. Further prayer is made for directing the respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.
- Status report dated 21.09.2023, by way of an affidavit of Mr. P. Abinandhan, SDPO, North East, Chandigarh, furnished by learned State counsel for U.T. Chandigarh, is already on the record.
- Considering the reply (supra), asked for direction is not required to be passed. Therefore, the instant petition is **disposed of**.
- However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to approach the appropriate Court/Forum, for redressal of her grievance, as raised before this Court.
