1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 12 and 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.12.2023 passed in LPA-734-2022.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.
4. Counsel for the respondent submits that vide order dated 13.12.2023 passed by the Division Bench, the aforesaid LPA-734-2022 has been dismissed and nothing survives in the present contempt petition. Otherwise also, the petitioner has been re-appointed on the contractual post.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order dated 13.12.2023.
