1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana whereby an application filed by the petitioner under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC for being impleaded as a party in the proceedings has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as counsel for respondent No.1 have jointly submitted that the matter has been settled by a memorandum of understanding dated 26.01.2023 whereby the property stands transferred in favour of the petitioner.
