As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹6,00,000/- (₹ Six Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that appellant No.1 has since expired and that the enhanced amount be given to appellant Nos.2 to 5 in equal shares, who are the only remaining legal heirs of the deceased.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹6,00,000/- in the respective names of appellant Nos.2 to 5 in equal shares with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 02.07.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance

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Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
