1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to issue passport to the petitioner against application dated 25.02.2024 (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned counsel for respondent/Union of India has filed a short written statement by way of an affidavit of Dr. Abhishek Sharma (IFS), Regional Passport Officer, Amritsar and has submitted that the matter has been looked into and respondents have sought the clarification from the Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, vide communication letter dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure R-3). It is submitted that application of the petitioner has been processed, however, the response from the office of Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur is awaited.
3. In light of the above, a copy of the paper book along with written statement be handed over to the learned State counsel who shall



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intimate the Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to expedite the police verification of the petitioner and for sending the same to the authorities-respondent No.2 within 15 days from today who shall proceed in accordance with law coupled with the fact that petitioner has already been discharged from the proceedings by virtue of Annexure P-4.

5. In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of.
