1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.168 dated 15.04.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sector-50, District Gurugram.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.05.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has deposited a sum of Rs.1.5 lakh subject to outcome of the trial.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 23.05.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. The concerned trial Court is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.1.5 lakh in a fixed deposit in some nationalized Bank fetching maximum rate of interest subject to outcome of the trial.
