SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The writ petition is disposed of with a mandamus upon the Appellate Authority concerned to within a period of two months from today pass a speaking decision upon Annexure P-20.
2. To ensure that substantial justice is done to the litigants concerned, besides to also ensure that the equities in respect of the subject lands are not disturbed during the pendency of the statutory appeal (supra). Moreover, to ensure that none of the litigants, thus in case possession of the subject lands is assumed thereovers by the litigant concerned, that too when the statutory appeal is subjudice, rather are led to ill recourse restitutory remedies, which would multiply litigation.
3. Consequently, this Court proceeds to set aside the impugned Annexure, whereby the Appellate Authority concerned, proceeded to vacate the earlier order passed by him, whereby he directed the parties to

maintain status quo in respect of the disputed lands.

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4. The further sequel thereof, is that, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* as of today in respect of the disputed lands.
