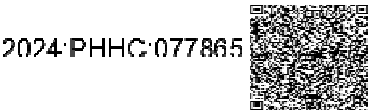

1. By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to conduct a fair, proper and speedy investigation in view of representation dated 10.04.2024 moved at the instance of the petitioner by registering an FIR or taking appropriate action against respondent No.4.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.



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4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Athar Ahmed, DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar to look into the representation dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
