The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.147, dated 02.06.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 (Section 465, 468 and 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not only on parity rather on better footing with the co-accused Gurpreet Singh, who has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 24.05.2024 passed in CRM-M-26544-2024 (Annexure P-18). He further contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating officer.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jaspal Singh Guru, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions

from ASI Ashok Kumar could not controvert the fact that the present petitioner is at parity with the other co-accused Gurpreet Singh.

In the light of above, for the sake of brevity, instead of going into the details of the facts and allegations qua the present petitioner, she is directed to be released on anticipatory bail subject to her joining investigation with the Investigating Officer concerned within a period of one week from today, on furnishing of personal/surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner shall also abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner does not comply with the aforesaid direction of joining the investigation within one week, the order passed by this Court today shall automatically stands cancelled.

The petition in the aforesaid terms stands allowed.
