KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate action against respondents No.6 and 7.

2. From the perusal of the record, it appears that earlier, respondent No.6 filed CWP-21780-2021 wherein direction was given to the concerned authority to decide representation dated 9.9.2021 (Annexure P-3) of respondent No.6 in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of order. In compliance of the said order, the competent authority passed speaking order dated 12.8.2022 (Annexure P-14).

3. I have heard counsel for the petitioner who is seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate action against respondents No.6 and 7.

4. Admittedly, till date, the petitioner has not made any representation with the competent authority and has not filed any criminal complaint with the police on the basis of the allegations levelled in the present petition against respondents No.6 and 7.

5. In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate legal remedy as is available on civil or criminal side. However, any observations made hereinabove, are not to be construed as expression of opinion on merits of the case.
