Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the Award/order dated 29.02.2024 passed by respondent No.1-District Magistrate, Yamunanagar, whereby inadequate compensation has been awarded to the petitioner.

Despite second call, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The position was same even on the last date of hearing.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that a similar controversy came up before this Court in CWP-17686-2024 titled as ‘Gurpreet Singh Vs. Learned District Magistrate, Yamunanagar and ors.’ wherein the petitioner has already withdrawn the said petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law, vide order dated 30.07.2024.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the order dated 30.07.2024 passed in the matter of Gurpreet Singh (supra).
