1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 31.01.2024 passed in CWP-1448-2023.

Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 31.01.2024 passed in CWP-1448-2023 has been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided while passing the speaking order dated 28.06.2024.
