NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appointment on compassionate ground in lieu of death of late Daya Ram, father of petitioner No.1 and grandfather of petitioner No.2, who died on 26.07.1994 while working as Mali.

2. After arguing the case for sometime and considering the fact that at this stage compassionate appointment cannot be claimed and granted, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to petitioner No.1 to make a representation before the respondents claiming ex-gratia payment on account of the death of her father, in accordance with the relevant instructions.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

4. If any such representation is filed by petitioner No.1 within a period of one month from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of 03 months thereafter.
