Present applications have been filed for fixing the writ petition to an early actual date of hearing and for disposal of the present petition in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 19238 of 2013 titled as **Amrish Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 26.02.2024.

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection for the grant of prayer as made in the present applications.



Keeping in view the averments made in the applications, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the applications are allowed and on the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for hearing today itself.

1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they are entitled for regularization of their services as their names have not been included in the seniority list of the department preferred for regularizing the services of the employees.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the similar issue has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP No. 19238 of 2013 titled as ***Amrish Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 26.02.2024 and the present petition be also disposed of in the same terms and conditions.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioners feel that their case is covered by ***Amrish Sharma and others' case (supra)***, and in case, any such representation is received from the petitioners, their claim will also be considered in light of the judgment in ***Amrish Sharma and others' case (supra)*** and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for the relief, the same will be extended to them, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
