DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

1. The present intra court appeal is directed against the judgment dated 09.05.2024 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court dismissing the appellant's writ petition through which he had sought issuance of directions to appoint him as a Constable (Sweeper) in the Central Reserved Police Force (for short – CRPF).

2. A few relevant facts may be noticed.

3. In response to an advertisement, the appellant applied for consideration of his candidature to be appointed as a Constable (Sweeper) in the CRPF. He passed the physical and written tests but since he could not pass the medical test which was conducted on 01.01.2011, he was not offered appointment. He sought review of his rejection and was again medically examined on 25.02.2011 but through report dated 06.09.2011 was again declared medically unfit. He challenged the denial by the respondents

to appoint him through filing of a writ petition which was dismissed by a



learned Single Judge of this Court. Such dismissal by the learned Single Judge is challenged through the present intra court appeal.

- 4. Learned counsel for the appellant has been heard.
- 5. The appellant seeks appointment as a Constable (Sweeper) in the CRPF which has been denied to him on the ground that on being medically examined he has been found unfit. Once, medical experts have examined the appellant twice over and found him to be medically unfit for appointment as a Constable (Sweeper) in the CRPF, it is not for this Court to question such decision especially when the opinion of the medical experts, on the basis whereof the appellant had been denied the appointment, was given 13 years ago and that the appellant seeks appointment to a paramilitary force.
- 6. Dismissed.
- 7. All pending miscellaneous application(s) also stand disposed of.
