1. Present petition has been filed for directing the official respondents for conducting free and fair investigation in FIR No.708 dated 21.12.2023 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town Rewari, District Rewari as the accused persons have links with the higher police officials and they can hamper the sanity of the investigation. Further prayer has been made to direct the official respondent to submit the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the FIR was registered on 21.12.2023 but till date there is no progress in the investigation.

3. Notice was issued in the present case on 04.07.2024 and status report dated 23.08.2024, was filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Suresh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, in the Court on 29.08.2024.



4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the case is being investigated by the DSP and the investigation is already in progress. He submits that the FSL report is awaited and on receiving the same, the investigation would be completed in a free and fair manner as in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Investigating Agency to conclude the investigation in the present case expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from today in a free and fair manner.
