1. The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner seeking transfer of investigation in case FIR No. 368 dated 21.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Section 406, 420, 467, 468 , 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala to some independent agency, under the supervision of a senior IPS officer to ensure fair and impartial investigation in the matter.

2. It is *inter alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner happens to be a senior citizen and a disabled person and complainant of the case FIR (Annexure P-1). Feeling aggrieved by the improper investigation, petitioner had moved representation dated

03.04.2023 (Annexure P-11) to Director General of Police (Punjab), Chandigarh, (respondent No.2) but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied, if, appropriate directions are accorded to the respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of Court, Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State and submits that the representation will be considered and disposed of in accordance with law in a expeditious manner.
5. Heard.
6. After considering the rival contentions and perusing the averments and also the limited request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of representation dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner.
