By way of present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 13.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from the



Investigating Officer of the case has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 13.09.2024 the following order was passed:-

“Explanations by way affidavits of Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur and Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, District Sangrur, dated 12.09.2024 have been filed and are taken on record.

S.I. Saurabh Sabharwal, Investigating Officer of the case is also present in Court.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Without commenting on the merits of the case at this stage, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

List on 03.10.2024.

Investigating Officer of the case is directed to remain present in Court on the next date of hearing along with record.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 13.09.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 13.09.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will

influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
