This third petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case bearing FIR No.85 dated 02.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 15/29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana. On 18.01.2024, this Court has dismissed the second petition on merits filed by the petitioner.

The learned State counsel submits that there is no substantial change in the circumstances and the petitioner is involved in two more cases under the NDPS Act. He further submits that when the petitioner was granted interim bail, he misused the same and was declared as proclaimed offender on 01.02.2023.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner and, therefore, the present petition stands dismissed.
