Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to issue a new/updated Domicile Certificate/Caste Certificate/Backward Class Certificate to the petitioner, so that she can avail the benefits of reservation in case of any opportunity that may accrue in her favour in future.

Learned State Counsel submits that earlier the petitioner had been applying through off-line mode, whereas the application was required to be submitted through on-line mode. He submits that, in any case, the requisite certificate has already been issued in favour of the petitioner and the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute the said fact, however, he submits that due to laxity on the part of the respondents in issuance of the certificate, the petitioner has suffered loss of opportunity and as such, the petitioner is entitled for compensation.



Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, so far as the claim of the petitioner as regards compensation on account of loss of opportunity is concerned, the same is an issue of fact and that the petitioner, if so advised, may take recourse to the appropriate proceedings for redressal of her grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
