1. This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to immediately look into and decide the representation dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-1).
2. Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409 and in M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on 20.03.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition with liberty to pursue alternative remedies in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and in case any such remedy is availed, then the same would be considered independently and in accordance with law.
