1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 29.08.2022 passed in CWP-18372-2022.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. R.P.S.Bara, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and files the compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.2. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 29.08.2022 passed in CWP-18372-2022 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
