By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 11.06.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mahender has



intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 11.06.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for petitioner inter alia contends that 1 kg 500 gms of Poppy Husk was recovered from the co-accused Raj Kumar @ Raju and on the basis of a disclosure statement suffered by him, the petitioner has been implicated. He further submits that though there are four other cases registered against the petitioner, he has been acquitted in one, is on regular bail in two cases and anticipatory bail in one case. He submits that no recovery has to be made from the petitioner and that he is willing to join investigation and abide by the conditions imposed by this Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, DAG., Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Complete copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

List on 24.07.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and join investigation. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to compliance of the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 11.06.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 11.06.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of



written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
