In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 08.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2-Assistant Director Consolidation, Haryana.

2. Counsel for the petitioner, while referring to the zimni order of even date (Annexure P-4) and the second order (Annexure P-5), which is under challenge, has submitted that two orders have been passed on 08.04.2024 and both the orders are contrary to each other. If that is so, it is always open to the petitioner to approach the concerned authority for rectification of the orders, as the said officer would be better placed to know about the observations therein.

3. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner submits he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the official respondent for the necessary relief.

4. Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to approach the concerned official respondent, for the necessary relief.
