AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants, Mr. Rajesh Arora has signed the proposal sheet. To settle this issue, he states that in case an amount of Rs.22,00,000/- more is paid, the amount already paid, this appeal can be settled. He seeks an adjournment to get instructions from the appellants as to whom and what proportion the above amount shall be paid.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 07.05.2024.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company. ”

Mr. Rajesh Arora, Advocate for the appellants signed the consent proposal on 30.04.2024, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.22,00,000/-(Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. Nitin Gupta, Advocate for respondent No.1-Insurance Company

has also signed the said statement today, accepting the proposal made by the

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counsel for the appellants.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.1-Kiran Grover. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No.1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.22,00,000/-(Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Only) favouring appellant No.1-Kiran Grover, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.07.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.
