1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying undertaking dated 11.10.2023 given by the respondent before the Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the undertaking which has been allegedly violated, was given by the respondent before the Court of Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order executed. Therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise his grievance before the concerned Court, but in accordance with law.
