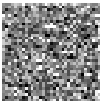

The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner seeking directions to respondent No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners and for that purpose, they had moved representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, on 03.04.2024 but till date no action thereon has been taken.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, P.S. E Division, Amritsar, has stated that the husband of the petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 and 3 namely Baljinder Singh is required to be arrested in case FIR No.15 dated 31.01.2024 registered under Section 302 and 34 of IPC at P.S. E Division, Amritsar, nor the police is harassing the petitioners in any manner.
