1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the common order dated 02.03.2024 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Amritsar vide which the application under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 CPC filed by respondent No.1 and application under Order 1 Rule 10 read with Section 151 CPC filed by respondent No.2 have been allowed.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 15.04.2024, the main suit itself has been dismissed for want of any cause of action under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC and the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the petition, in case, any cause of action survives.
