1. The learned counsels appearing for all the contesting litigants before this Court submit that as declared in the impugned Annexure P-23, that the litigants may establish their right, title and interest in respect of the subject lands, thus through theirs respectively accessing such statutory civil remedies, as prescribed in the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, thereby the counsels appearing for all the litigants are further are ad idem that the writ petition be allowed and the present petitioner may be granted liberty to access lawful remedies for his becoming enabled to establish right, title and interest over the disputed lands.

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3. The said remedies be ensured to be positively canvassed within a period of one month from today and thereupto the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* in respect of the subject lands.
