1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to the Investigating agency to allow the petitioner to virtually participate in the investigation in case FIR No.43 dated 29.06.2022 registered at Police Station Women, Sector 51 Gurugram, District Gurugram.
