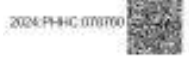

Counsel for the petitioner submits that dead body of Abhishek son of petitioner was found lying at a railway track on 10.02.2024 and thereafter, police authorities failed to take any action and in this regard representation dated 05.03.2024 was also given by the petitioner to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to do the needful. That petitioner being aggrieved has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking necessary direction in this regard. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take further action in accordance with law on the basis of Annexure P-2 against the real culprits.

3. Mr. Viney Phogat, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.
