The present writ petition has been filed for seeking directions to respondents to remove the encroachments in the shape of Gardens with Hedges/Grills made by the house owners whose houses are situated in the Improvement Trust Colony Scheme No.5-Gurdaspur, for smooth functioning of roads and for the convenience of the persons.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents-Municipal Council, District Gurdaspur undertakes to remove the entire encroachment over the public land in the Colony developed by the

Improvement Trust within a period of three months.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the respondent-Municipal Council, Gurdaspur, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the prayer in the present writ petition was for removal of those unauthorised encroachments.

Let a compliance affidavit be filed by the Executive Officer of the Municipal Council, Gurdaspur after a period of four months and before expiry of five months.

In the event of the needful not been done, the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Gurdaspur shall deposit a cost of Rs. 2 lakhs, to be recovered from the Executive Officer in person for non-compliance and to be deposited with “**Poor Patients Welfare Fund**’ of the **Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh**”.
