NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This order shall dispose of all the above-said writ petitions, as common question of law and facts are involved for adjudication. For the sake of convenience, facts are taken from CWP-11693-2016 tilted as 'Sheeba Kadyan Vs. State of Haryana and another'.

2. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking the following reliefs :-

“(i) To issue a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the practice adopted by the respondent-University to discontinue/relief the petitioner during vacations/breaks period (including summer vacations).

(ii) To issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-University to grant/release full salary and allowance for the vacations/breaks period (including



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summer vacations) to the petitioner from the date of his appointment on the post of Assistant Professor/Guest Faculty.”

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-University has raised objection that the petitioners have approached this Court seeking a writ of mandamus, however, they have not approached the department for redressal of their grievances.
4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel(s) for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petitions with liberty to first approach the competent authority for redressal of their grievances by submitting a detailed representation.
5. If any such representation is submitted by the petitioners within a period of 01 month from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the respondent-University within a period of 03 months thereafter.
6. Disposed of in the above terms.
