Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide security to the petitioners, who are apprehending danger to their lives at the hands of the respondents No.3 and 4.
