1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-authorities to release the salary of the petitioner for the month of March and April, 2024 as admittedly the same is not being paid by the respondent-authorities without there being any fault on the part of the petitioner with a further prayer to direct the respondent No.5 and 6 not to harass the petitioner when there is no role of the petitioner in FIR No.28 dated 27.10.2023, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station ACB (Anti Corruption Bureau), Ambala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had given a representation dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-13) to respondent No.3 by way of a registered post regarding which receipt has been shown in the vernacular of Annexure P-13 but the same has not been considered and decided



till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-13) is considered and decided by respondent No.3 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-13) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
