AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Gagandeep Singh @ Bobby has filed petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0033 dated 14.02.2024, under Section 21 C and 29 of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

2. As per the facts of case on 14.02.2024, ASI Jaspal Singh and police party was going on routine patrol duty and when they reached near Krishna Garden Colony, Amritsar, they saw two young boys coming on a motorcycle. They were apprehended on the basis of suspicion who disclosed their names as Vikas son of Rajesh and Honey son of Late Sukhwant Singh. From their possession, allegedly 510 grams of heroin was recovered. Present petitioner is named during investigation.



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3. On filing of present anticipatory bail petition, petitioner was granted relief of *interim* bail vide order dated 31.05.2024. Relevant part runs as under :-

“xxx

xxx

xxx

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

4. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that Gagandeep Singh alias Bobby has already joined the investigation and he is ready to abide by terms of bail order.

5. Learned counsel representing State confirmed that petitioner joined the investigation on 08.06.2024 and he is not required for any other purpose. It is further confirmed that challan in this case has been presented on 08.08.2024.

6. Petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose. No recovery was effected from his possession. Challan is also presented and trial is likely to take some time. Therefore, without going on merits, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioner – Gagandeep Singh alias Bobby vide order dated 31.05.2024 stands confirmed, subject to conditions as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Petition is accordingly allowed.

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8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
