Present petition has been filed seeking quashing of order dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P-15) passed by respondent No.4, thereby refusing to accept Mutation No.3981 Village Sullar, vide which the fraudulent and incorrect Mutation No.1487 Village Sullar was corrected, thereby restoring title of the property in favour of Petitioner-Trust, in the revenue records.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there lies a remedy against the impugned order and he would approach the Appellate Authority against the impugned order and thus, he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to avail his remedy of filing appeal before the authority concerned.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, However, the petitioner is at liberty to file appeal before the



Appellate Authority as per the mandate. On his doing so, the authority concerned would deal with and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law. In case, any stay application is filed along with the appeal, the same would be dealt with on priority basis within a period of 10 days.

For the period of 10 days, no coercive action be taken against the petitioner.
