**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (Oral)**

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari/Mandamus quashing the charge-sheet dated 29.11.1990 (P-2) and its subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as the same are wrong, illegal and unlawful, unjust, unfair, unconstitutional, and declaring the same as deemed to be dropped after such a long period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the benefit of Leave Travel Concession, gratuity and arrears of regular pension have been released to the petitioner on 01.07.2024. However, the same have not been calculated on the correct basic pay of the petitioner and further, since there is considerable delay, he is entitled to interest as well.

Considering the claim of the aforesaid benefit of the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall file a detailed representation with the concerned quarter, within a period of one month from today, the same shall be considered by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner.

Let the petitioner file a representation within a period of one months from today and the same shall be considered and disposed of by respondent No.2, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of representation and if the petitioner is found entitled to the benefits as claimed in the representation, the same be released within a period of one month thereafter.

This Writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
