1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 and of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of the private respondents.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation on 21.05.2024 (*Annexure P-3*) before respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Panipat raising her grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Panipat to decide the

aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Panipat to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.
