1. This common order shall dispose of the above-mentioned two petitions.
2. The present petitions have been filed against the order dated 27.03.2019 passed in appeal, whereby the interim order dated 13.06.2016 passed

by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar in a peition filed under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 was modified directing the petitioner No.1-Inder Bir Jit Singh in CRR-1740-2019 to pay monetary relief qua rent as well as maintenance of the child.

3. There is no such order which is criminal in nature having been passed in appeal vide above-said impugned order, as such in view the decision given by this Bench, in CRM-M-58023-2023, titled Gautam Singal vs. Anju Singal, decided on 30.11.2023, the present petitions are not maintainable.
4. In view of the above, the present petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail appropriate remedy as per law.
5. Both the counsel for the parties submit that they will not oppose each other applications for condonation of delay.
6. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
