The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-11) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, 1st Grade (Naib Tehsildar), Patran, District Patiala; order dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-12) passed by the learned Collector (S.D.M.), Sub Division Patran, District Patiala; and order dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-13) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies, in accordance with law.
