Perusal of the file shows that the matter pertains to the year 2017 and notice of motion was issued on 18.09.2017. Thereafter, for two consecutive dates i.e. 25.09.2018 and 05.02.2019, the petitioners have gone un-represented. On the next date of hearing i.e. 21.03.2022, the matter was adjourned, at the joint request of learned counsel for the parties. Again, on the last date of hearing i.e. 06.09.2022, the petitioners have gone un-represented.
