ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. In this revision petition, the correctness of the interlocutory order passed by the First Appellate Court in civil miscellaneous appeal has been challenged.

2. The plaintiff filed a suit along with an application for grant of injunction which was dismissed by the trial court. He filed an appeal which is pending for 19.09.2024. However, his prayer for grant of ad-interim injunction was refused. While issuing notice of motion, no interim order was granted. The civil miscellaneous appeal is pending for nearly 1 year and 2 months.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the First Appellate Court is requested to make sincere endeavours for disposal of the appeal on the next date of hearing or by granting a short adjournment.

4. With these observations, the revision petition is disposed of.

5. Needless to observe that the First Appellate Court will independently decide the appeal uninfluenced by the observations made in

the impugned order.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
