1. The present petitions have been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 29.05.2013 (Annexure P-9), passed by the respondent vide which the candidature of the petitioner in NCB Examination 2011 was cancelled and debarred for a period of five years from the Commission examination.
