In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he is not being allowed to compete for the post of Associate Professor.

By an interim order dated 19.06.2019, the petitioner was allowed to appear for interview provisionally and the result was ordered to be kept in sealed cover.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that minimum 25 marks were required to be scored by a candidate in the interview, which the petitioner has failed to secure, hence, even otherwise, if the petitioner would have been treated eligible, he could not have been selected keeping in view the criteria fixed for appointment to the post of Associate Professor.

Nobody is appearing on behalf of the petitioner from the last two dates. Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.



Keeping in view the above, it can be safely presumed that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
