Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to stop further investigation in the matter as the investigation has already been completed by respondent No.5- Deputy Superintendent of Police, PBI, Homicide and Forensics, Kapurthala).

In pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 05.06.2024, status report dated 08.07.2024, by way of affidavit of Harpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kapurthala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 has already been filed.

At the outset, learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report and has submitted that no complaint or enquiry is pending qua the petitioner and thus, the petitioner is not wanted in any complaint. He thus submits that nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication and the same be disposed of as infructuous.

In view of the status report filed by the State, there is no complaint pending against the petitioner and he is not wanted by the State in any case.
