By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code
of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR
(Annexure P-5) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in
compliance to the order dated 04.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner



has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Purshotam Lal has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor she is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 04.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ Mr. Abhishek Khullar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that with the intervention of respectables, the parties have effected compromise and the complainant Gurpreet Singh has given affidavit dated 29.06.2024. The same is taken on record. He further submits that on instructions from the complainant he has no objection for grant of bail.

3. List on 25.07.2024.

4. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 04.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 04.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of



written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
